200 CLUB

Rules of Membership

For the modest contribution of £5 a month you will be supporting the valuable work of Tattenhall Community Association, and giving yourself the chance of winning up to £1500.

For a payment of £5 each month, you will be entered into a draw with a maximum of 200 members. Each monthly draw will have the following prizes (see note 11):

With maximum membership the following prize money will be available: 1st Prize £100, 2nd Prize £50, 3rd Prize £25. There will be a half year draw with a prize of £500 and, at the end of 12 months, a Grand Prize of £1500 will be drawn.

All you have to do to enter is complete the attached application form and standing order form, authorising monthly payments. You can also pay by cheque, either annually, half yearly, or quarterly. Forms should be returned to Tattenhall Community Association (TCA), the Barbour Institute, High Street, Tattenhall CH3 9PX in a sealed envelope addressed to Pat Black, The Promoter.

The Rules are as follows:

1. The 200 Club will be operated under The Lotteries and Amusements Act 1976, Section 4, Private Lotteries. The promoter will be Pat Black on behalf of Tattenhall Community Association.
2. TCA reserves the right to amend the rules of the 200 Club from time to time, as may be necessary. In that event a copy of the up to date rules will be available from the Barbour Institute Office.
3. All money raised by the 200 Club, after payment of prizes, will be used to support and improve the facilities at the Barbour Institute.
4. The Lottery will be limited to 200 members over the age of 16 years.
5. The subscription will be £5 per month, payable by standing order on the 1st day of the month (or annually in a single payment of £60, to be made before the first day in October each year). Applicants can also pay by cheque in one annual payment of £60, half yearly or quarterly. On receipt of the application form and completed Standing Order form or cheque payment, the applicant will be allocated a Draw Number. No applicant may hold more than 5 numbers.
6. The draw will take place every month. Winners of prizes will be notified by telephone or email, and the results of the draws will be available for inspection at the Barbour Institute on the main notice board and on the Barbour Institute and Tattenhall websites.
7. The 200 Club Year will run from 1st October 2016 to 30th September 2017. Applications received during the Club Year will only be eligible for prizes on a pro rata basis based on the date of entry.
8. The draws will be conducted by 3 people, one of whom will be the Chairman or a nominated person.
9. No 200 Club member will be included in the draw if the appropriate subscription has not been received by the fifth working day of the month before the draw takes place. The Promoter reserves the right to reallocate any number where payment has not been received on time.
10. Prizes will be paid by cheque and given only to the person with the winning number. You will be required to produce your membership card showing the correct number before the prize is paid.
11. In the event of there being less than 200 participants, prizes shall be awarded pro rata based on the actual number of members at the time of the draw.
12. Members can cancel their entry at any time by giving one month's written notice to the Promoter (and if paying by Standing Order, they should also advise their bank). Any decision by TCA to wind up the 200 Club will also be by one month's written notice.
